PONDERINGS OF THE PASTOR

⁶When they entered the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a white robe sitting on the right side. The women were shocked, ⁶but the angel said, "Don't be alarmed. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Look, this is where they laid his body. ⁷Now go and tell his disciples, including Peter, that Jesus is going ahead of you to Galilee. You will see him there, just as he told you before he died." --Mark 16: 5 - 7

Dear friends in Christ,

Alleluia! Jesus Christ is risen from the dead! He is not in the tomb - he is risen and on the loose!

Mission Action God's Work Our Hands

We spent March gathering items for Personal Care Kits. All of us are so lucky to have so much because there are so many people in this world with less. A powerful witness to this is a story from the International Orthodox Christian Charities (IOCC) who help get these quilts and kits into the hands of those in need. A priest in Jordan told this story. "One of our most active church members-a woman who faithfully attends mass, makes home visits to indigent Christian families and helps the church in reaching these poor-asked me to visit her family late one evening. I thought she had a family problem. Upon arriving, I was shocked to see that she was poorer than the poor she visits to help. Her two children sleep on the floor atop a torn mattress with very light sheets covering their thin bodies. Her husband earns around \$220 a month, not enough to meet their basic needs. Shyly she asked me, "I like the kits and the quilts you give me to distribute to the poor families, and I ask you if I may have two quilts and two Personal Care Kits for my children for Easter." The following night I carried 2 quilts and two Personal Care Kits and 2 toothpaste packs with some food rations towards her home. She kissed my hand, asking me to thank IOCC and LWR for assisting her two children, 5 and 7 years old. I went back home thinking of how many people are deprived of the wealth that we enjoy every day.

It is a reminder to us all that we play an important role in God's redemptive and restoring work that is happening RIGHT NOW. Let's join together with gratitude in this work that we have been so gratefully given.

The LWR quilters are in need of Cotton or cotton blend fabrics that we an cut into squares for mission quilts. Any size is needed as we cut the larger pieces into the sizes we use.
